

### A very wet April in Southeast La.

Unlike a relatively dry March, April rains came with a vengeance. Several slow moving and even stalling fronts moved into position to offer rain chances on several occasions. The wettest days appeared to be the 11th, 12th, 14th and 19th when the wettest locations measured over 3 inches. However, only the 12th had an average over 1 inch for all reporting stations. With 19 days having measurable rainfall across the state, accumulations tallied over 10 inches at 6 locations statewide, all in the New Orleans metro area. Marrero 1.9 E on the west bank of the met-

ro area had 15.84 inches for the wettest location in April. Several area rivers and streams stayed at elevated levels for much of the month. The reds in image are

greater than 6 inches and the pinks/purples are greater than 10 inches. The state hail reports numbered five in the month of April, with the most notable coming from Gray 0.5 ENE (LA-

TR-5) on the 13th at 11:15 pm with penny to grape sized hail that evening. Also on the 14th, Shenandoah 1.5 E (LA-EB-22) reported pea sized hail at 1:45 am. In the Shreveport areas, pea sized hail was reported from two locations on the 10th and another report from Benton, LA came in on the 1st with 1/2" to 3/4" hail stones.
