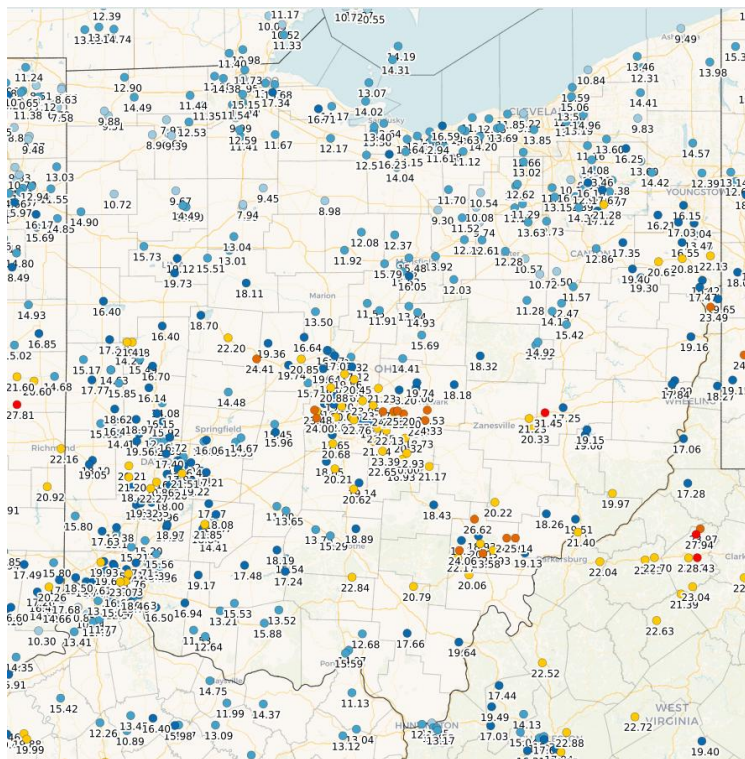

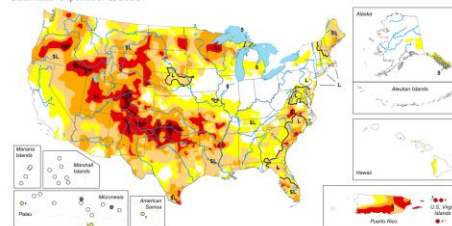

Rainy Days

While some parts of Ohio have seen significantly more rainfall than others over the last 90 days, most locations have had above normal rainfall. For some of us the ground still squishes as we walk across our yards even here in September which is statically typically a drier month.
