


USA Network growth of 39.7% over 10 years, 4.5% growth in Year 2019.

USA Network growth of 37.2% over 10 years, 0.8% growth in Year 2019.





  - Be ready to spot your favorite locale(s)... and write down numbers... quickly.






## Net Change: Active Stations between May 2, 2019 - May 3, 2020












Net Change  $\geq 1$ : Active Stations between May 2, 2019 and May 3, 2020



Net Change =0: Active Stations between May 2, 2019 and May 3, 2020




Net Change <= -1: Active Stations between May 2, 2019 and May 3, 2020













# 2,968 Stations where LastReportDate = Year 2018






